<sup>1</sup> By reference to the Suffragan Bishops Act 1534 and Crockford. (Penrydd in Pembrokeshire – listed as ‘Pereth’ in the 1534 Act – is also dormant having been vacant since 1539. As it is no longer in the Province of Canterbury it is not available as the see of a suffragan under the 1534 Act.) Other unfilled Welsh sees – not subsequently used for diocesan sees - were created by Order in Council following the 1888 Act at Cardiff, Carnarvon, Holyhead, Monmouth & Wrexham.
